Upon receipt of this application the nomination chairman will pass the information on to the selection board which consists of the Nomination Chairman, three past presidents, and any active members so appointed by the President. They are charged with verification as to qualifications of each candidate to fulfill the duties of each office.

The Nomination Chairman will then pass all eligible candidates on to the Executive Board.
The Executive Board will select a ticket of the most qualified candidates. (At January's E.B. meeting)

The President will then place the Executive Board selected ticket before the membership for their consideration at the Club's regular January meeting. The President will ask for any challenging nominations of previously vetted nominees from the floor. If there are any the President will acknowledge the challenging nominees and ensure the Secretary and the nomination chairman have the information.

A run-off election of contested offices will take place immediately during the January Club meeting.
The run-off election winners and non-contested offices will then be voted on for the Club offices by the members.
