Reports to: MVGC Junior Club Advisor and MVGC Club President

Job Overview: Preside over the Youth membership of the MVGC. Work with the Junior Club Advisor to insure the following takes place. Educational programs at meetings and at special called meeting. Work with the Educational Specialist to showcase the Club to Schools, Libraries and other requested authorized events.

Provide information as to the likes and dislikes of the younger membership.

Insure outings are planned and followed up with.

You will represent the Club adult membership to youth and the youth membership to the Adults.

Duties:

Job Overview: Lead person in the MVGC in dealing with issues in the following areas.

Represent the MVGC in dealings with Membership under the age of 18 year.

Lead and teach the Club in areas of needs, concerns, and actions dealing with the larger issues of training, Collecting and Rock Hounding. Insure that learning and fun is achieved.

Teach and be an example to Club members on field trips about the Clubs Code of Ethics.

The Code of Ethics is found on all their membership cards.

Insure the Youth members have a combined or separate Show Cases at the Show. (Insure Quality).

Work with Advisor to make a yearly calendar of monthly YOUTH CLUB outings and have copies ready to handout and place in the Gem News on January 1st. of each year. (Modification of schedule is permissible.)

Monthly, at the club meetings, insure information is presented on areas of interest, concerns, and responsibilities

(Between President and Advisor) Ten minutes will be available for a report during the business session.

Submit monthly news articles with the Magic Valley Gem News.

Keep a binder of information about all activities outings and who went. (Include adult advisors) Insure Copies are kept with the Club Advisor, the Youth President, and keep it updated.

Work with other clubs to keep informed of what is happening in the Rock Hounding World of Juniors.
