

## MVGC Minutes from October 15, 2020

The MVGC meeting was held in American Legion Hall in Twin Falls, ID

Meeting was brought to order by President Jon Cromer. 9 members and 1 guest were present.

I reported that the club is in very good financial condition. The club can pay for all bills that come due, in normal operations, for some years if there is no other income due to Covid or other unseen events.

Randall DeBoard stated the club trailers are in good shape at the storage place. Rocky Metts reported last year's annual show numbers. Rocky stated that the Excel spreadsheet he was using on the club finances was full of bugs that needed worked out to function properly. This report will be attached with this club minutes report.

The first thing of order was discussing next year's dues. Rocky offered that club could just roll over all active club members from 2019 to 2020. After some discussion a motion was made to make this happen. Drew H motioned, Randall D seconded, club approved. The club will pay for the membership fees dues to Northwest Mineral Federation for 2021.

The second item brought to order was the dealing with the upcoming Executive Board elections. I still want to step down from the President position. It was brought up and discussed that I could step down at the end of the year. Randall DeBoard offered to step in the President position at the start of the New Year. I offered to temporary fill the Vice President position till it can be filled by election. Rocky Metts offered to stay in the Treasury position. Rebekah Yancey has offered to temporary fill the secretary position. The EB election is being moved to next year in December 2021. I ask that all other EB members stay on till the new election next year. Randall D made a motion on this, Judy M seconded, club approved.

The third item brought to discussion was what to do with next year's MVGC annual show. This was discussed from many angles, whether to even have it (cancel the show), still have it with modifications, move the date of the show to fall, have dealers only, and what to do with the dealers with our decision. If Covid conditions are like they are now, the club could not have a show, per state mandates. It was suggested that a question to be put out on the club's Facebook page asking, people that live in this area, "Should we have an annual show in 2021, and if we did, would you attend?" Nothing was decided about this and I advised club members to think about it and we will talk about it some more at the next club meeting.

Randall DeBoard won the monthly drawing.

Club meeting was adjourned.
